

Annual Report of Sumaithangi Trust for the year 2020-2021

Sumaithangi Trust is a social service organisation engaged in sponsoring awareness campaigns to bring about a social change. As a non-profit organisation, we are dedicated to “Serve the Most in Need”. We are mainly working for the welfare of women, migrant labourers, unorganised workers, Disabled people, Children’s education, especially for Tribal children. As soon as the beginning of the financial year 2020-21, the human society faced a huge crisis of Covid-19 lockdown since the end of March.

The year 2020 brought the human race to a face “The First Pandemic of this millennia”, People living below the poverty line had to migrate long distances to earn a livelihood and be with their loved ones. The Trust rose up to the occasion by collecting food items and providing the same relief kitchens and also facilitated mass feeding on migrant labourers.

On 17th April 2020 with the Co Ordination of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board (TNSCB) Covid relief material distribution was done in Chemmenchery tenements and Perumabakkam and supported 1,800 families.

During the month of May 2020, Covid Relief materials (groceries weighing 20 Kilogram including Rice, Daal, Oil, Masala Items, Sugar, Soaps, Vegetables etc) were distributed to 1000 (One Thousand) like hearing impaired, blind and retarded peoples.

On 5th May 2020, our Trust reached out to 500 (Five Hundred) Irula Community Tribal families living in Thiruvalluvar District and distributed groceries and food stuffs, weighing 20 Kilograms, which included Rice, Daal, Sugar, Oil, Masala items, Soaps etc.

Distribution of relief materials to 160 families, like Corporation Workers, Temporary Contract unskilled labourers in ward no-93, Mugappair on 22nd May 2020.

We extended help to the needy people by providing the groceries of 20 Kilograms which included (Rice, Dal, Sugar, Oil, Soap, Masala Items etc.,) at TNSCB CRRT Tenements to 500 evicted families at Navalur with the co-ordination of Star Health and allied Insurance Pvt Ltd.

We provided rice, oil and thoor dhall , Biscuit packets to Sathya Nagar- A,B and C Area, Fort St.George, Chennai-600009 for 460 families.

Sumaithangi Trust in Association with Tribal Society, distributed the Covid Relief materials to the Narikuravar Tribal families living in (Eraiur-Perambalur District about 200 families), (Thirupathur- Sivagangai district about 150 families), (Thozudhur- Cuddalore District approximately 50 Families and distributed groceries to all the above mentioned families.

Our Trust has given help to the Military Hospital located at Ekatuthangal by providing the essential medical equipments- 1 Unit of Para Monitors and ventilators.

Covid Relief Materials have been distributed to the 50-Auto Drivers, 59- Corporation Covid work Volunteers, 97-Cleaning Workers/Scavengers, and 1000- Domestic Workers across Mugappair area in Chennai.

Our Trust also distributed Covid Relief materials to support the old age people identified and supported through Help Age India, Kilpauk, Chennai.

The Trust has provided laptops, tablet phones and smart phones to the needy slum dwelling children to make it possible for them to attend online classes during the lockdown.

We found that there was a need to focus/assist on the children education in remote areas, so we initiated evening tuition centres in Perumbakkam and provided salary to the Teachers and other internal support to the Children and the parents for education.

2 Creches were established in the slum areas in Sathya Nagar –B extension area and Neelam Basha Dharga with 25 children in each centre. We support the Teachers and the Assistant (Aaya) with the salary to keep them engage free to the kids for education, also provided 2 tablet phones to the to assist the Children with the innovation in teaching children.

We are also providing mid day meals, daily refreshment and nutritious snacks to the children studying in the crèche. To encourage the students in the Diversity and exposure about the society we celebrate the National Festivals like Republic day, Independence day, Gandhi Jayanthi, Childrens day and also the Festivals like Pongal, Diwali, New Year, Christmas etc.,

We run a free residential home for women at Mogappair east, Chennai and they are supported for their education.

Supported the Narikkurava Tribal community People affected with Niravi and Puravi Cyclone with the Groceries(food Stuffs), Mat and Bed Sheets etc. In Mailam with 25 Families, Thozhudur with 80 families, Koozhiyanoor Kootrodu with 50 families.

With the co-ordination with For You Child organisation, we provided Bed sheets, mats and biscuits to 100 families of Irulas community at Pazhaverkadu, Thiruvallur District due to the affect of Niravi Cyclone.

Provided Rice to 300 Construction Labourers who lost their work due to cyclone in, who are living in Puducherry.

Our Trust continuously provided 3 times of meals everyday to the domestic workers who resided in transit homes till 13th December 2020 in Chennai due to the covid pandemic situation.

We support by giving marriage donation gift money and also things/materials to our domestic workers Son/daughters when they approach us for help and when they invite us for the marriage.

Sumaithangi Trust is dedicated towards on supporting the educational activities to the needy students, especially supporting the student to pay the tuition fees for the higher education/Professional courses. In that way we have supported 70 students with the fees, and helping them to continue their education, also we are supporting with all forms of support to the same student with the books, Stationeries, Exam fees, Hostel Fees, Mess Fees to the students.

On 28th February 2021 organised Siddha medical Camps to the Slum living people in Chennai and 75 people benefitted from this camp. In the past we have conducted general health camps/medical camps/ eye camp/ Dental treatment/siddha Treatment camp with the help of Apollo hospitals, Sankara Nethralaya, Thai moogambigai dental College. Due to covid pandemic lockdown we were not able to conduct medical camps during the FY 20-21.

Future Short Term Goals:

Sumaithangi Trust has decided to take up the empowerment programme for women, Youth and Labourers by sharing Knowledge and skills.

Proposed to launch, "Women Self Sustainable Economic Empowerment programme". We are aiming to reach out at least 5000 women.

Support the Labours to register in Welfare board online with zero amount and encourage them. Propose to support Youths, by providing them basic skills of Computer education and other education activities.

In order to make the above activities possible we are in dire Staff salary and Asset/material support has been stopped since April 2020 due to covid pandemic lockdown order by Government and it is expected to start June 2021 for Narikuravar Schools at Eraiyur-Perambalur district and Thirupattur -Sivagangai District

Staff salary and asset/material support by the Government is to be paid for Government school children free evening tuition centre which is run by Nansei organisation, at Kalambur, Thiruvannamalai District. This centre is to be focused by us as the literacy percentage is less in that district and to change that by giving a value education to the students.

In this year we have planned to conduct all these medical camps so that many poor and needy people will be benefited out of it.

The Trust would like to pay salary to 2 teachers for Nansei organisation that will run the evening tuition centre at Kalambur, Thiruvannamalai District. The centre will be our main focus in the year.

Without Corporate gifts and sponsorships dream of uplifting rural area students will always remain a pipe dream. To make Tamilnadu a 100% literate district we definitely need/look forward sponsorships and if possible corporate mentorships. We are willing to work along with and co-operate at all levels.

The Trust would very much like to bring a change in the mindset of rural parents/grand parents about "The Girl Child". Her place in society, her contribution to the society etc. This needs in-depth work with many kinds of tools, Pamphlets, cartoons, drama troupes to enact plays etc. We also need the where with all to work along with National Organisations to eradicate female infanticide.

During the past years through your support we were able to reach many poor and needy and full fill the requirements. The same way we are looking forward all possible help from you so that we can out reach more number of people those who needs support.

As a founder of the Trust, I put forward to you a compilation of our activities and sincerely request help in all and any form. Any New project is undertaken.
